- To find a location near you, type in your town and state in the Location or Call Sign box on the left.

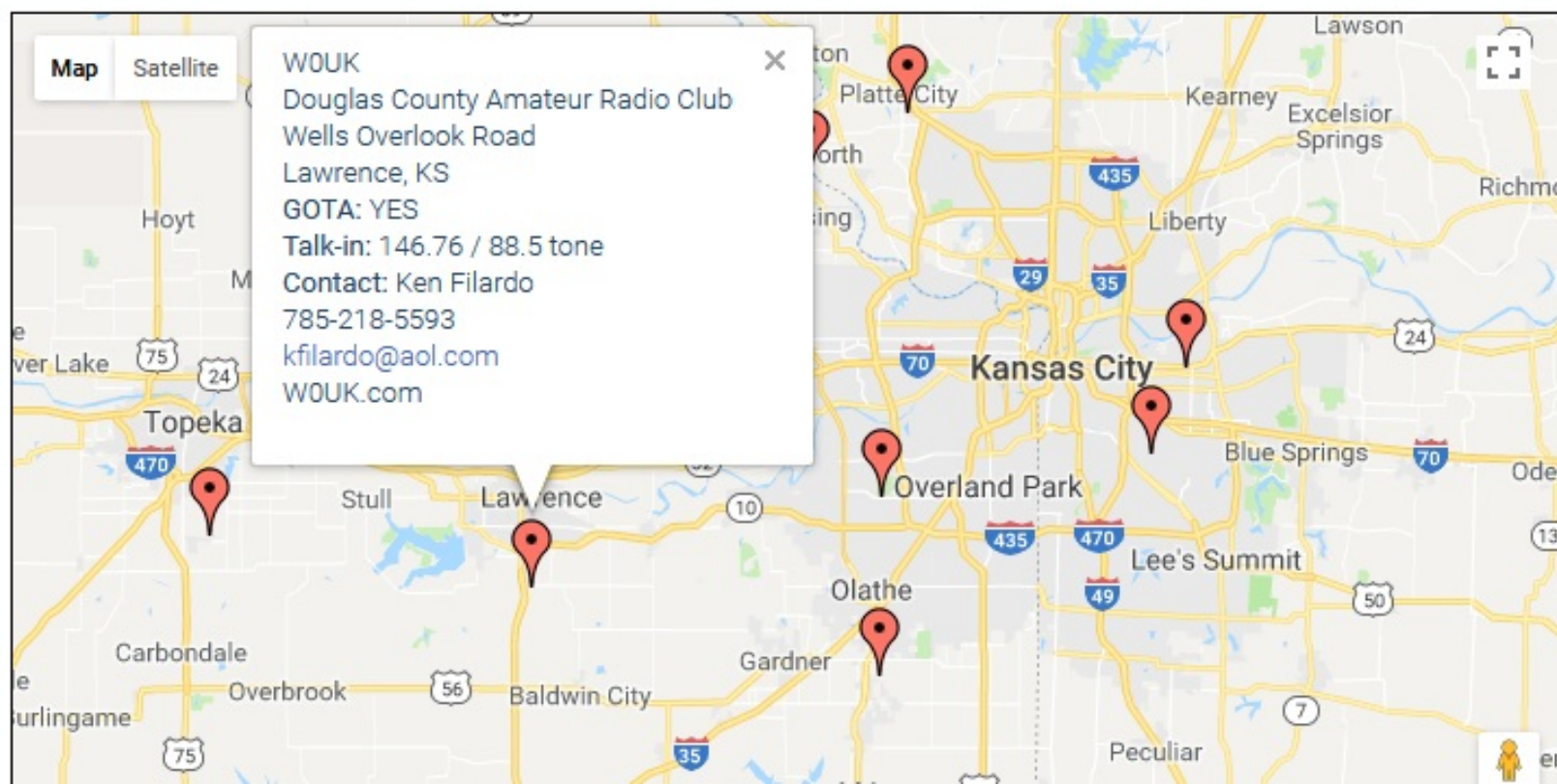
